29th July 2024: -

A temporary prohibition of all traffic restriction has been put in place to allow BT Openreach to carry out utility works which are expected to commence 12th August 2024 and anticipated to take 3 days to complete.

N.B: due to the nature of the works it is not possible to maintain access for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists through the extents of the temporary road closure.

Access for Emergency Vehicles will be maintained where required for the duration of these works.
