February Allithwaite Report

Community Orchard: Volunteers are presently undertaking winter pruning which should be completed by the end of February. A request for a set of extendable pruning shears has been received from our volunteers, an order will be placed shortly as will the annual order for various feeds.

Allithwaite Quarry: Now that the safety work has been completed, the newly formed working group needs to meet and to discuss the 10 year plan and how to progress it.

King George V Playground: The funding awarded by the PC to KGV has been acknowledged as received.

Community Center: January meeting cancelled, however, the centre bank balance as of January 24 was £12,146.57.

Health and Safety signage has been completed and toilet and roof repairs undertaken.

Allithwaite Allotments: A report of a water leak has been received, however after an inspection of the sites taps/pipes by councillor Sim and one of the tenants nothing has been found.

The fence between the cottage and allotments has still not been repaired due to the the recent bad weather and high winds. Council to chase up.

Allithwaite Bus Stop: The recently purchased no parking sign which has been fitted to the shelter has been well received by residents as it the "message" seems to be working well so far.

Free Mini Library: Still a heavy demand, our volunteer has requested a small number of shelf book ends which will be ordered shortly.
