ALLITHWAITE REPORT.

A quiet month for Allithwaite with little to report.

Allithwaite Mini Library

Unfortunately, the library had to be closed for a short period in the last month. This was due to inappropriate use of the facility. The library was opened as soon as practicable, an apology note for the interruption was displayed. Still a very popular facility which we hope will not be abused.

Allithwaite Community Orchard and Meadow

Concerns had been expressed by residents and users with regards to over growing brambles on the permitted footpath which runs parallel to Vicarage Lane. The contractor was contacted and the remedial action was undertaken within 24 hours. Similarly, overhangs were reported on the St Marys footpath they to were dealt with by our Lengthsman within 24 hours of being reported.

Wartbarrow Lane

The Lane has been closed for drainage repairs, a diversion is in place but unfortunately notice of the works only arrived from W&F Council after the work had been started.

Allithwaite Roads (Church Road)

The PC expressed concerns with regards to the general state of highways in Allithwaite in particular Church Road. Councillor Sim was tasked to contact W&F Council to check if the council had any future plans to improve/repair any roads in the village. Coun Sim reports that he has failed to speak to any individual and has emailed the department again failing. Coun Dean to try for a response through his contacts directly.

Noisy Dogs

A number of concerns have been expressed by residents with regards to noisy dogs, residents have been pointed to W&F Council who have the powers to take any necessary actions if required.
