## A590 Ayside to Brettargh Holt Initial NoW Letter: 19/09/2024

Following on from recent communications regarding the Average Speed Cameras we plan to install on the A590. This email is to inform you of survey works we plan to carry out from the 23 September to inform the detailed design of the scheme. Please see the below details of dates, location and traffic management.

### Monday 23 September

Overnight lane 1 closure westbound between Brettargh Holt and A6 Levens Junction.

### Tuesday 24 September

Overnight 2-way traffic lights in phases between Foulshaw Moss and Meathop dual carriageway.

### Wednesday 25 September

Overnight lane 1 closure eastbound at Gilpin Bridge with the eastbound exit slip to access the A5074 closed. Traffic will be diverted via Brettargh Holt to use the A590 westbound junction.

Overnight lane 1 closure westbound on Meathop dual carriageway with no access / egress onto the A590 from the U5623 junction, a clear signed local diversion route will be in place via Meathop.

#### Thursday 26 September

Overnight lane 1 closure eastbound on High / Low Newton bypass with a closure of the eastbound exit slip road into Low Newton, a signed local diversion route via Meathop roundabout will be in place.

Overnight lane 1 closure westbound on High / Low Newton bypass with a closure of the westbound entry slip road from Low Newton, a signed local diversion route via Meathop roundabout will be in place.

Overnight priority system on Cartmell Lane under the A590 bridge.

# Friday 27 September

Overnight 2-way traffic lights in phases between Ayside and Newby Bridge.
